By request from teachers, this module shines a spotlight on human interaction with nature and its resources, and how we can all make choices to tread lightly in our use of energy, food, clothing, water and waste. Students engage with global issues through critical thinking and hands-on activities with real-life actions to take home and implement.

Please note:

- A maximum of 5 x 45minute workshops will be run per school day
- Workshop times will fit into your school timetable
- Only one enrolment class per session, supervised by your class teacher
- Workshops can be conducted in classrooms
- All workshops require a working interactive whiteboard or projector/screen
- Follow up lesson material is available to teachers after each workshop
- Days and places are limited, so book early
- These workshops are fun, interactive and relevant!
