



Keeping everyday little items out of landfill at the Foreshore Markets, 2nd Saturday of each month

- Aluminium Foil - rolled into a ball about the size of a Rockmelon.
- Batteries (*household*), incl. hearing aid & other button batteries, lithium ion, etc.
- Beauty Product Tubes & Plastic Containers – **MUST be empty**
- Bottles, Cans & Poppers (*beverages only*)
- Bread Bag Tags - cardboard – *collect in an A4 envelope, then they can go in the yellow bin*
- Bread Bag Tags - plastic
- Clothes Hangers – *metal, plastic, timber*
- Coffee Capsules – *Nespresso, L'OR, Moccona, Illy, Campos, Jeds*
- Coffee Cups and Lids
- Corks
- Dish & Air Care Packaging (*incl. bottle caps, spray & trigger heads*) – *see separate list*
- DVD's CD's Cases & Discs
- Elastic Bands (Reuse)
- Fluorescent Tubes & general light bulbs – *not LED*
- Glasses – *optical*
- Hair Care Aerosols – **MUST be empty with the caps on, see attached list**
- Joggers
- Medical Blister & Webster (*Foil backed*) Packs - *used for prescription drugs, Panadol, etc.*
- Paper & Cardboard
- Pens & Markers
- Plastic Garden Pots (no.5 PP)
- Plastic Lids/Bottle Tops
- Plastic Pill Bottles
- Scrap Metal – small items
- Tea Bag Tags
- Ties – wire & plastic
- Toothpastes Tubes, Toothbrushes & Razors (blades removed)
- Smoke Detectors, Mobile Phones, Laptops & Computer Accessories
- X-Rays

*All items must be empty & clean for onward to specialist recycling facilities
